A Tribute to Merry Olde England 7/21

It's "High Tea" - as in *Te Deum* - as a thrilling opening night program awaits, featuring the Lancaster Festival Orchestra and Lancaster Chorale performing the world premiere of English composer Patrick Hawes' *Te Deum*. Maestro Gary Sheldon conducts an all-English program including beloved favorites *Greensleeves* and *Lark Ascending* with violin soloist Stephanie Sant'Ambrogio.

Chamber Music Classics-Prizewinners 7/26

Prizewinning ensembles and solo musicians from the Lancaster Festival Orchestra are featured. Maurice Ravel's gorgeous *Introduction and Allegro* for harp, winds and strings headlines a program of chamber music classics.

Orchestra Concert- And the Winner is!... 7/29

Celebrate the Lancaster Festival Orchestra's American Prize award along with performances by other award-winners. Celtic Fire with the Lancaster Festival Orchestra 7/23

It's a night of Celtic magic as the Lancaster Festival welcomes a bit of Ireland. Featuring the voice of Riverdance on Broadway, **Michael Londra**, **Celtic Fire** combines traditional Irish music and dance in a show that will make you feel like you are visiting the Emerald Isle.

FAMILY CONCERT - Pinocchio Ballet 7/24

The beloved Pinocchio story comes to life with BalletMet's outstanding dancers and choreography by **BalletMet** Artistic Director **Gerard Charles**. This world premiere production includes a beautiful musical score by Hungarian composer David Kiraly, performed by the **Lancaster Festival Orchestra** conducted by **Gary Sheldon**.

Boogie Woogie at The Lodge 7/25

Enjoy a night of blues and boogie woogie as the legendary Mr. B returns to the Festival. The **Mr. B Trio** will have you captivated all night. Mr. B (Mark Braun) learned his craft by playing in blues and jazz bars with the early masters of the genre.

Unforgettable Fire - The U2 Tribute 7/27

Get on Your Boots and enjoy the music of one of the world's most popular bands. As one of the first U2 tribute bands in the States, Unforgettable Fire is dedicated to creating an authentic U2 concert, in both appearance and sound. Enjoy some favorites such as *Beautiful Day* and *Where the Streets Have No Name*.

A Tribute to James Brown and Prince 7/29

Two music legends are celebrated with this tribute. The excitement of "the Godfather of Soul," James Brown, "the hardest working man in show business," and the sounds of Prince, one of the most talented, commercially successful pop musicians of the last thirty years will bring the dance floor alive tonight with Arnett Howard and Friends.

Grand Finale with The Beach Boys and the Lancaster Festival Orchestra 7/30

Forty years ago, **The Beach Boys** burst on the scene and the sounds of summer were forever changed. From *Good Vibrations* to *Kokomo*, the Beach Boys are recognized as one of the most influential bands in American music. They were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1988 and given the Lifetime Achievement Award at the 2001 Grammy's and their popularity has never waned. The evening and Festival celebrations concludes with a fantastic fireworks finale set to music.
